## PRIVACY STATEMENT

### The information we obtain from you:

#### Subscribers (Members)

- Your name and postal address
- Telephone number
- E-mail address (if available)
- Membership application for the current year with any donation.

#### Mailing List

- Name and e-mail address.

We do **not** collect financial information from you. All other information as listed above will be retained securely and will not be shared with another party unless we are required to by law.

### We use your contact details to:

- Keep you informed about forthcoming events involving Milngavie Heritage Centre.
- Distribute membership cards.
- Give notice of general meetings and to issue other notices from time to time.
- Be able to contact you personally if circumstances require it.

However we do **not** share your personal data with any other organisation.

### How we protect your personal information

Your personal data is held securely and is accessed by our Secretary and Treasurer. Data protection is ensured by our designated Data Protection Officer.

### How long we keep your personal information

We keep the data for as long as is necessary for appropriate reference and to provide you with a membership service. You remain on our mailing list unless you ask to be removed from it.

Membership application forms will be retained for the year.

### You have a right to:

- Access the data we hold about you if you request it.
- Request that we correct your data if you believe it is inaccurate or incomplete.
- Request that we change the way in which we communicate with you..
- Request that we delete your personal information.
- Unsubscribe from our mailing list.
